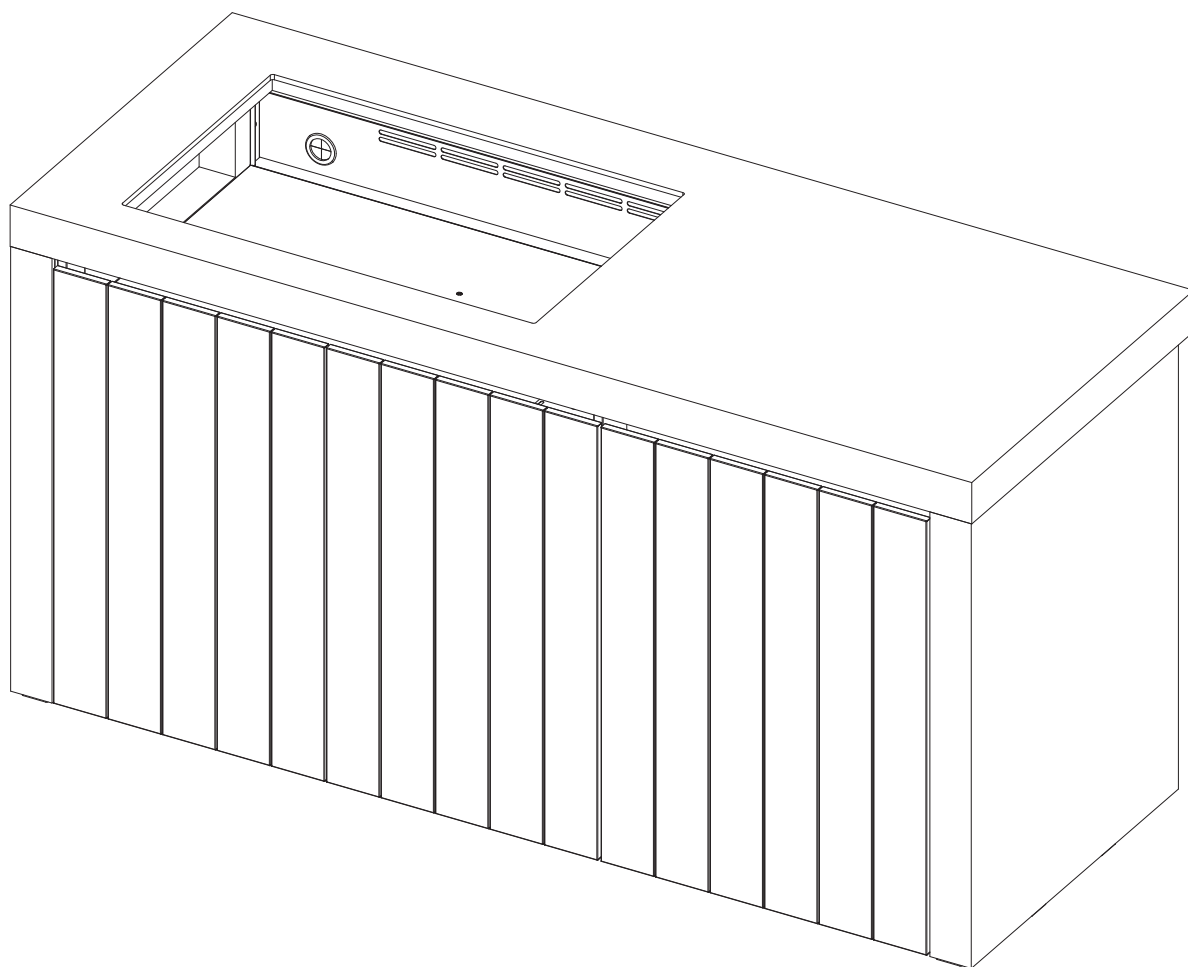

Note: In this instruction manual, the BBQ module will be referred to as an appliance

Read these instructions and follow steps carefully to ensure you assemble the appliance correctly and avoid damages. Check that all parts and hardware have been provided before assembling the appliance. Place all contents on a clean, soft-flat surface to avoid scratching the product

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTION:

WARNING:



- **DO NOT** climb, step, or stand on the appliance.
- **DO NOT** use the appliance for any purpose other than that for which it is designed.
- **DO NOT** exceed the maximum weight for countertop 70kg (150lbs).
- Keep the appliance on a level surface. It may become unstable if stored or moved on a sloping surface and may cause personal injury, and/or damage to the appliance.
- Always apply leg stabilizers once the appliance has been moved to the area.
- To prevent damage to threads, do not use a power tool and do not overtighten screws.
- Do not use or store this appliance in areas of high salt content (a marine environment) or an area with caustic fumes or liquids (such as a domestic pool), as these chemicals can cause the appliance materials to deteriorate (and void the warranty).
- This built-in barbecue module is for **OUTDOOR USE ONLY** (semi-covered areas, protected from wind and rain). This appliance must **NOT** be used indoors. Follow the assembly and operational instructions of your barbecue in all ways.
- We recommend that you regularly maintain your module and keep them in good condition. This can be achieved by following the cleaning suggestions in this booklet.
- Use two people to lift and to turn the appliance when assembling.
- Do not attempt assembly with one person.
- Keep all hardware and small parts away from children.
- When moving the appliance secure any items placed on top to prevent damage or personal injury.

PACKAGING:

- Remove all external packaging and remove the appliance from the packaging before use.
- Removal all internal cartons and packaging from within the appliance assembly.
- Recycle as per local government laws

GENERAL:

It is recommended that, at the commencement of each barbecue season, the following maintenance be conducted on the built-in barbecue module.

- Check all fasteners for tightness and re tighten where necessary to ensure rigidity of the structure.
- Check that the separation panel is firmly fixed in place. This includes the small fixing panel around the gas hose.
- Check for insect infestation and clean out any cobwebs.
- Check that all vents are fully open and not blocked.
- Check for any leaks at the water inlet pipes and at the wastewater pipes.
- Check the seal around the sink, as this can deteriorate over time and allow water to seep into the module.

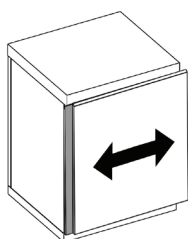
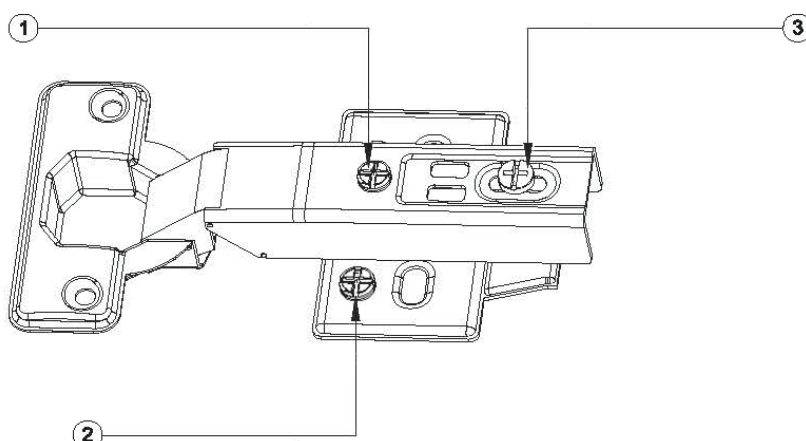
CLEANING:

Surfaces can be cleaned using a mild household detergent or cleaner and a clean cloth (do not use scourers or harsh detergents). It is advisable to test cleaners on a small section of the appliance first. NEVER use paint thinners or similar solvents for cleaning and NEVER pour cold water over hot surfaces. Dry the surface afterwards. DO NOT use high pressure cleaners or steam cleaners, as this can damage the module surface causing it to break down and lift away.

STORAGE:

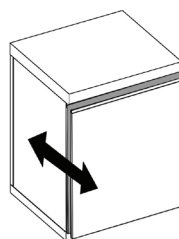
When the appliance is not in use, MUST be under cover and covered (preferably with a purpose made cover) out of the weather

HINGE ADJUSTMENT:



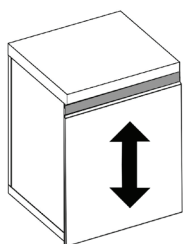

This screw adjusts the distance from left to right



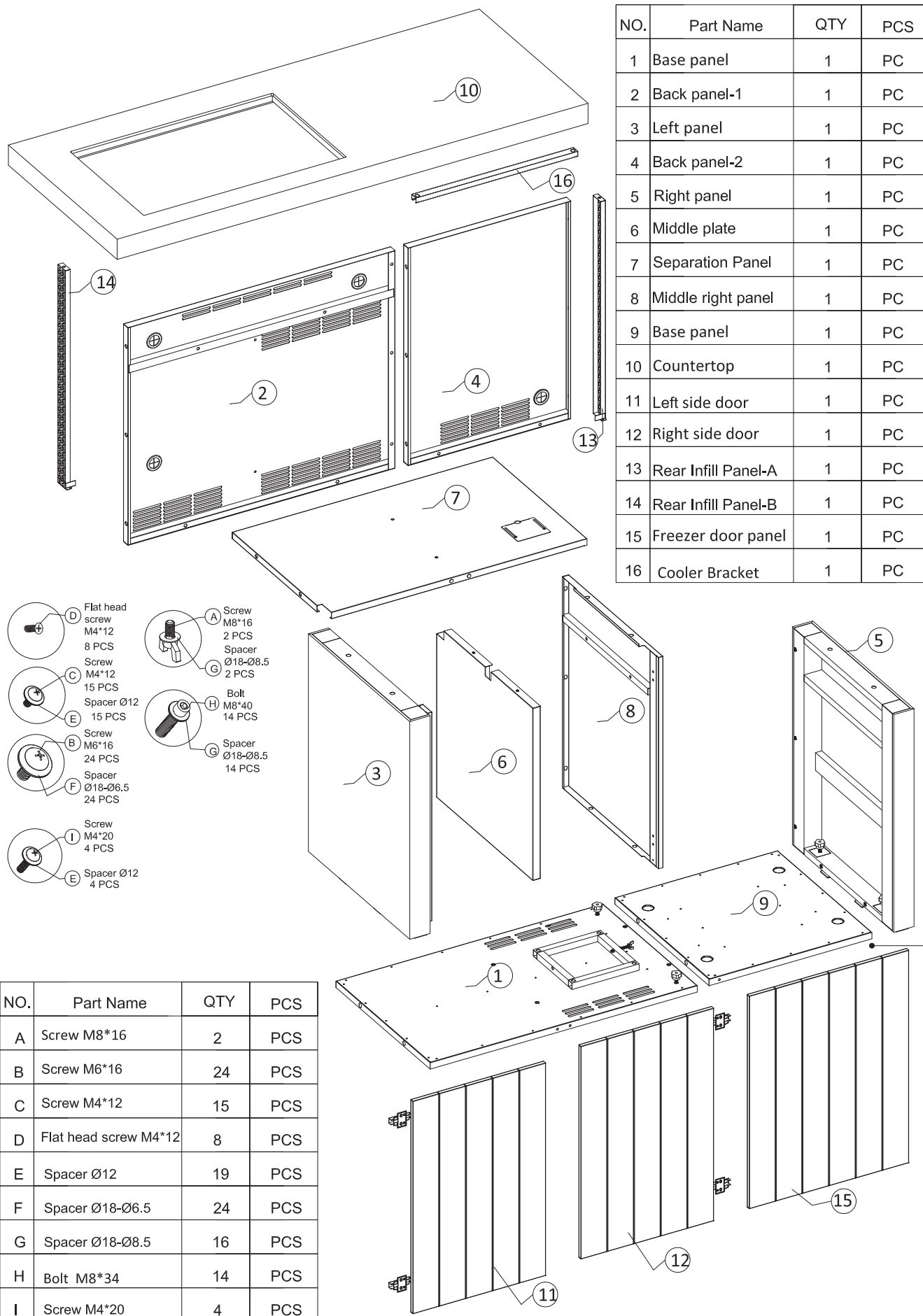

This screw adjusts the distance from front to back



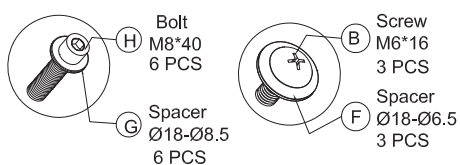
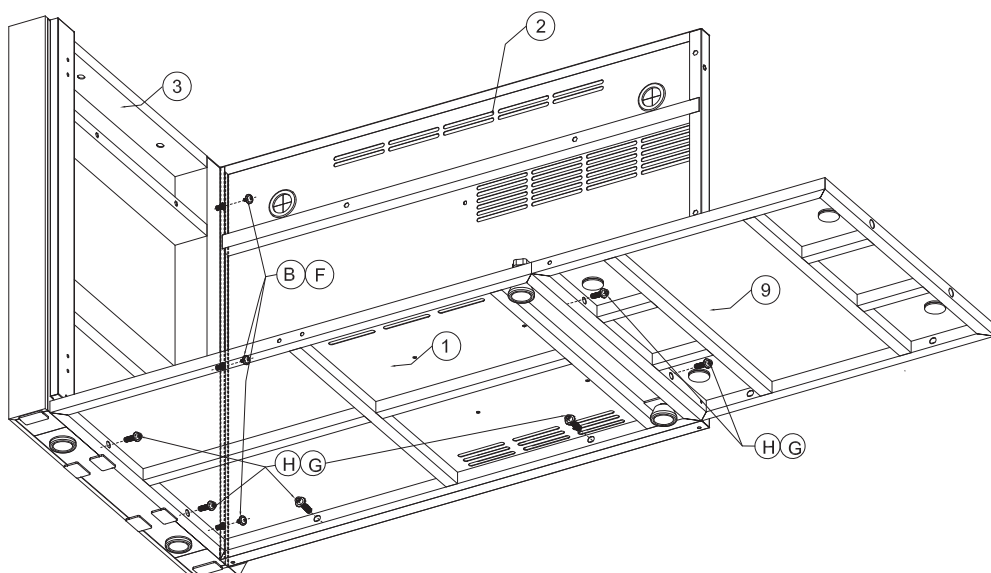

This screw adjusts the distance up and down

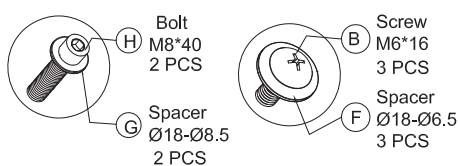
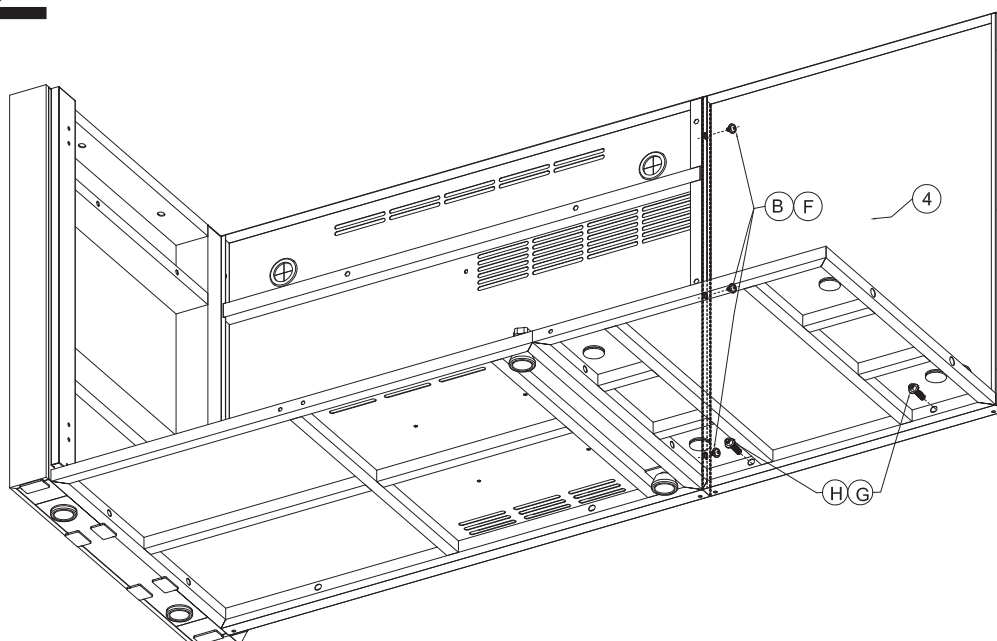

You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.

OUR WARRANTY

Subject to the following conditions, this product is also covered by the manufacturer's warranty from the date of purchase, covering all parts and labour for the period listed. Our warranty (which is subject to the conditions below) covers rectification free of charge of any fault arising from defected materials or components, or faulty workmanship. The product will be repaired or replaced at the option of Artusi (Worldwide Appliances), but all costs of installation, removal, cartage, freight, travel expenses and insurance are to be paid by the claimant. Our Warranty is subject to appliances being used for single-family domestic household use.

Our warranty operates in addition to (and does not exclude, restrict, or modify) any rights or remedies to which you may already be entitled to under the Australian Consumer Law or any consumer guarantee law relating to this appliance.

WHAT IS COVERED: By Our Warranty

During the warranty period your appliance will be repaired free of charge by Artusi (Worldwide Appliances), or its authorised service centre provided your appliance is delivered to and picked up from Artusi (Worldwide Appliances) or its authorised service centre, subject to terms and conditions below.

It is recommended that exposure of the appliance to the elements should be minimised. After the appliance has been cleaned, store it under cover with a weatherproof cover over it.

The benefits provided by the consumer guarantees on this page are in addition to other rights and remedies available to you as a consumer under the Australian Consumer Law act.

Each of the components of your AOK1900 Artusi Outdoor kitchen carries specific warranty conditions detailed below.

The sintered stone bench carries a warranty of 10 years and includes colour and structural integrity (cracks, chips or any user identified damage caused by the user are not covered) All steel elements carry a warranty of 5 years against material failure.

WHAT HAPPENS IF THERE IS A PROBLEM?

If/when you unbox your item/s and there is an issue with any of the pieces, please contact www.wwa.com.au before assembling the product. If the product is assembled with any damaged pieces, a labour charge to repair any damaged panels may apply.

Artusi will examine the product and decide if it's covered under the standard product warranty. Artusi reserves the right to, either repair the defective assembly component or replace the unit as a total. In these cases, Artusi will be responsible for the costs of the replacement of the assembly components only.

Any repair work or modification to the product undertaken independently by the consumer or installer without the consultation or notification to Artusi will result in a void of warranty for the assembly component in question. Any defective parts removed in the course of repair works will become the property of Artusi.

This guarantee applies to domestic outdoor use only and covers all of the following parts of the AOK1900 outdoor kitchen:

- Cabinet frames
- Door panel
- Hinges
- Stone mouldings
- Bench-top and bookend legs
- Vanity panel

WHAT IS NOT COVERED: By Our Warranty

1. Any defect or failure caused by the appliance not being assembled or used in accordance with the instruction/installation manual provided with the appliance.
2. Normal fair wear and tear (e.g., surface rust & discolouration).
3. Insect or vermin infestation.
4. Unauthorised repairs or use of non-genuine Artusi (Worldwide Appliances) parts, appliances and products
5. Appliance scratches & damage as a result of delivery, installation, or assembly.
6. Claims to appliance surface coatings due to accidental damage, improper or lack of maintenance, damage from cleaning not recommended by Artusi (Worldwide Appliances).
7. Door handles, weather damage resulting in irreparable damage or rust.

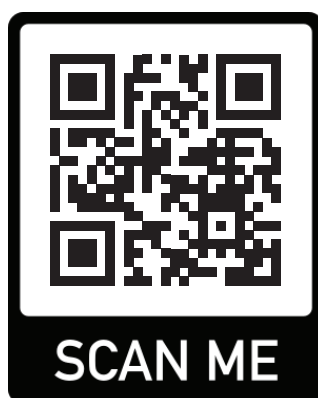
