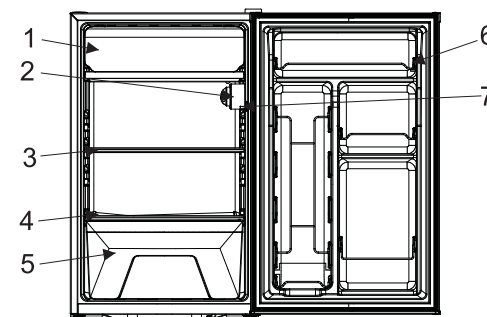

- If you use the refrigerator for the first time, remove the adhesive tapes of the drawers, balconies, egg tray, and the drain tube plug.
- Do not pull or push the drawers and balconies fiercely during use in case of damage.
- Adjusted the temperature control as higher as you could accept, which will save the energy consumption of the refrigerator and your money;
- Don't open the refrigerator door continually if it is in the normal working situation.
- Keep the combination of drawers, baskets and shelves of the refrigerator is consistent with its original standard.

SAFETY WARNINGS

For ensure your personal safety, please follow the points below:

1. The circuitry for refrigerator must be isolated. The area of cross section of wire must be larger than 0.75mm^2 . The power plug should have its own socket, the socket must be ground as adapter may cause the socket to overheat.
2. The voltage and frequency of this product should be 220-240V;50Hz. Contact with the local maintenance station or retailer if the wire is damaged.
3. Do stop the power only by pulling the power plug out of the socket directly but not by the wire.
4. Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
5. This appliance is not intended for use by persons(including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
6. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
7. Keep ventilation opening, in the appliance enclosure or in the built in structure, clear of obstruction.
8. Before you throw away your old refrigerator or freezer.
 - Take off the doors;
 - Leave the shelves in place so that children may not easily climb inside.
9. Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance. This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as
 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farm houses and by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments;
 - bed and breakfast type environments;
 - catering and similar non-retail applications.
10. Do not use electrical appliance inside the food storage compartments of the appliance, unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacture.
11. This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
12. This refrigerating appliance is not intended to be used as a built-in appliance.

Children aged from 3 to 8 years are allowed to load and unload refrigerating appliances.

To avoid contamination of food, please respect the following instructions:

- Opening the door for long periods can cause a significant increase of the temperature in the compartments of the appliance.
- Clean regularly surfaces that can come in contact with food and accessible drainage systems.
- Clean water tanks if they have not been used for 48 h; flush the water system connected to a water supply if water has not been drawn for 5 days.
- Store raw meat and fish in suitable containers in the refrigerator, so that it is not in contact with or drip onto other food.
- Two-star frozen-food compartments are suitable for storing pre-frozen food.
- One-, two- and three-star compartments are not suitable for the freezing of fresh food.
- If the refrigerating appliance is left empty for long periods, switch off, defrost, clean, dry, and leave the door open to prevent mould developing within the appliance.

WARNING: When positioning the appliance, ensure the supply cord is not trapped or damaged.

WARNING: Do not locate multiple portable socket-outlets or portable power supplies at the rear of the appliance.

WARNING: Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.

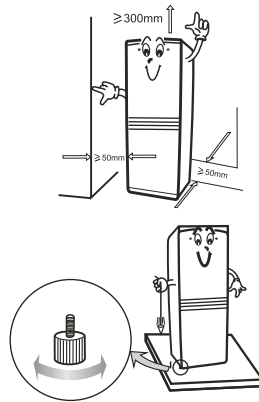
NOTICE:

1. When gas leaks from its container, don't pull the plug, out or in, for it may arouse sparks and fire calamities.
2. Don't splash water on the rear of the appliance, for it may cause malfunction or electric shock.
3. Don't stor inflammabe materials such as ether, benzene, LP gas and glue etc in the refrighterator.
4. Don't place bottled beverage in the freezer, so as to prevent breaking.
5. It is better not place object on the top of appliance which is magnetic, heavy, or be filled with water. Electronic components may not work steadily if water gets inside. Do not store object which is costly or impressible to temperature and , e.g. serum, bacterin and so on.
6. The refrigerant of this product is R600a, which is inflammable. So, make sure not to damage the cooling system during the transportation and installation. The refrigerant and insulation blowing gas are flammable. When disposing of the appliance, do so only at an authorized waste disposal centre. Do not expose to flame.
7. DISPOSAL: Do not dispose this product as unsorted municipal waste. Collection of such waste separately for special treatment is necessary.



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. The refrigerator should be located in a completely flat surface, Leave 5~10 cm between each side of the appliance and the wall, and leave 30 cm between the top of the appliance and the ceiling.
2. Choose a location which is not exposed to sunlight, high temperature or humid, as humidity may cause stain.
3. Pulled out the bottom panel before installation.
4. The appliance can be adjusted by rolling its two legs in front the bottom when it is unstable. Rolling in clockwise can rise up the machine.
5. The location should be firm and flat. An un-securely position may cause noise and libration:
(a) The noise may be increased if the floor is not firm.
(b) Put a sheet under the appliance for solving the heat emission if you need to locate it onto a carpet.
6. Make sure the adjustable legs are clung to the floor, and set the appliance slope backward slightly for keeping the doors closed tightly.



OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

PLACEMENT OF FOOD

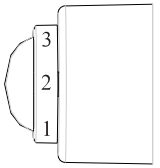
1. There should always be some space between items inside for air circulation.
2. Food should be kept in sealed package to avoid becoming dry or with odour.
3. Hot food should be cooled down before placing into the appliance. Otherwise, interior temperature and electronic consumption will increase.
4. Reduce the frequency of door opening can efficiently low down the electronic consumption.



Warning Do not use any electronic equipment inside the appliance.

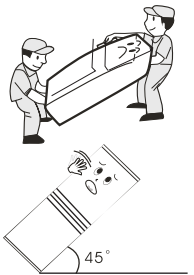
INSTRUCTION FOR USAGE

The temperature of refrigerator can be controlled manually by the knob. However, the number shown on the knob does not directly represent the temperature. Instead, the larger the number is, the lower the interior temperature will be. 0 stands for off. 7 stands for the coldest temperature level. The temperature in every apartment will be at the lowest degree under this level, and it probably make it below 0°C in the fridge department, so please choose carefully before you use. Turn the knob to level 4 when it is normal, turn it to the level 4-6 if a lower interior temperature is required; contrarily, lower to 4-1, when a higher one is needed.



PACKING AND MOVING

1. Unpack, repack and carry
Please memorize the position of each accessory of the appliance when unpack it, repack the product and check it carefully before transportation.
2. Do not lift or pull the door or the door handle during transportation.
3. When moving, the appliance can not be sloped over 45 degrees (the angle to the vertical direction). Please avoid strong vibration and hit.



MAINTENANCE

The appliance should be maintained and cleaned frequently. For your safety, do please pull the plug out of the socket before the cleaning.

1. Interior maintenance
Clean the interior of the appliance with clean water or neutral abluent. Scour it with clean water and wipe it with a piece of dry cloth.
2. Maintenance of door gasket
It is easy to damage if the door gaskets are polluted by the stain like oil, sauce and etc., so it is better to clean them carefully.
3. Outer maintenance
Wipe the dusty with a piece of dry cloth, clean it with neutral abluent if necessary.
4. The appliance is equipped with a screwing lamp or a long life LED interior light.

DEFROST

The heavy frost will influence the refrigerating of the appliance and increase the energy consumption. Thus, defrosting is needed as the frost is as thick as 5 mm. Processes of the manual defrost are listed as following: take all the food out of the compartment; uninstall the drawers and shelves; unplug the electronic power cord; open the doors and wait for the thaw; wipe up the water with dry cloth.



Do not use any other equipment or method to push the defrost process. It may destroy the cooling system.

DISCONNECTING THE APPLIANCE

After power failure, even in summer, the refrigerator can store food normally in several hours.

1. Discontinuation during power failure

After power failure, do not put additional food in the appliance and reduce the frequency of door opening. Make several ices in a container if know the power failure beforehand, and put it in the top of the fridge.

2. Discontinuation during vacation

Please fetch out the easy-rot food and the food in fridge before shot vacation. After confirmation, close the door firmly. If have a long vacation, please fetch out all the food and cut off the power. After defrosting, clean up the liner of the appliance and wipe it dry, and leave the door open.

3. Stop using

If the refrigerator may be stopped using for a long time, please unplug the outlet and clean up the appliance. The door should be kept open in order to prevent unpleasant smell caused by food leavings.



Attention

In a general condition, do not stop the appliance in case of affecting its life. After unplugging the power, please leave at least 5 minutes before resumption.

USER NOTIFICATIONS

1. Do not splash water on the refrigerator, as it will cause oxidation and malfunction. Electronic component such as on/off button should be wiped dryly.
2. Cleansers such as soap powder, abrasive cleaning powder, alkali cleansers, chemical cloth, thinner, alcohol, acid petroleum product and hot water should not be used to clean the refrigerator as they may damage the painted cover and plastics.
3. Smear can damage the interior plastic component, so wipe it as soon as possible.
4. Please check the points below after maintenance:
 - (1) Is there any damage or loss of the electronic wire?
 - (2) Can the plug be put in the socket reliably and smoothly?
 - (3) Is the plug heating unconventionally?



Warning

Please get rid of the gasket of the door before the disposal. The disposed apparatus should be handled by professional staff, as it may be harmful to the environment.

TROUBLESHOOTING TIPS

1. The refrigerator does not work
It may not be connected to the power supply (plug, power cut or fuse); Voltage is too low.
2. The refrigerator does not work efficiently as expected
It may be caused by heavy frost, or by warm temperature setting, or by frequently door operating.
3. It makes unusual noise
It may be caused by an imbalance or loose ground locating the appliance, or by resonance between the appliance and other ambient objects.
4. The compressor keeps working for a long period
The environment temperature may be too high. The doors may be opened frequently or even they are left open. The temperature control knob setting in (4-7) state may increase the working time of compressor.
5. Disgusting odour happens
Food with strong odour should be packed tightly before being put inside the appliance. Please check whether there is any deteriorated item or whether the liners are left dirty for a long time.
6. Water leaks from the bottom of the refrigerator
The drain tube is jammed. Please use a proper tool to solve it.
7. Heavy frost occurs on the rear of the appliance
Putting humid or hot food into the appliance may cause this problem. Or it may be caused by the heavy environment moisture.

The follow cases are not malfunction

1. Moisture may form dew on the outside of the product during the humid season, just get it wiped.
2. The flow of refrigerant through the pipeline coil can cause a bicker.
3. It is normal that the sides of product get warm as a result of the cooling pipeline working.
4. The frame of the appliance will be warm during working by the defrost pipeline inside it.

Please check the points above first.

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

HINTS AND TIPS

HINTS FOR ENERGY SAVING

1. Fridge: Most efficient use of energy is ensured in the configuration with the drawers in the bottom part of the appliance and shelves evenly distributed. Position of the door bins does not affect energy consumption.
2. Do not open the door frequently or leave it open longer than necessary.
3. Fridge: Do not set too high temperature to save energy unless it is required by the characteristics of the food.
4. If the ambient temperature is high and the temperature control is set to low temperature and the appliance is fully loaded, the compressor may run continuously, causing frost or ice formation on the evaporator. In this case, set the temperature control toward higher temperature to allow automatic defrosting and to save energy this way.
5. Ensure a good ventilation. Do not cover the ventilation grilles or holes.

HINTS FOR FRESH FOOD REFRIGERATION

Good temperature setting that ensures preservation of fresh food is a temperature less than or equal to +4°C.

Higher temperature setting inside the appliance may lead to shorter shelf life of food.

- Cover the food with packaging to preserve its freshness and aroma.
- Always use closed containers for liquids and for food, to avoid flavours or odours in the compartment.
- To avoid the cross-contamination between cooked and raw food, cover the cooked food and separate it from the raw one.
- It is recommended to defrost the food inside the fridge.
- Do not insert hot food inside the appliance.

Make sure it has cooled down at room temperature before inserting it.

- To prevent food waste the new stock of food should always be placed behind the old one.

HINTS FOR FOOD REFRIGERATION

Meat (all types): wrap in a suitable packaging and place it on the glass shelf above the vegetable drawer. Store meat for at most 1-2 days.

- Fruit and vegetables: clean thoroughly (eliminate the soil) and place in a special drawer(vegetable drawer).
- It is advisable not to keep the exotic fruits like bananas, mangos, papayas etc. in the refrigerator.
- Vegetables like tomatoes, potatoes, onions, and garlic should not be kept in the refrigerator.
- Butter and cheese: place in an airtight container or wrap in an aluminium foil or a polythene bag to exclude as much air as possible.
- Bottles: close them with a cap and place them on the door bottle shelf, or (if available) on the bottle rack.
- Always refer to the expiry date of the products to know how long to keep them.

TECHNICAL DATA

The technical information is situated in the rating plate on the internal side of the appliance and on the energy label.

The QR code on the energy label supplied with the appliance provides a web link to the information related to the performance of the appliance in the EU EPREL database. Keep the energy label for reference together with the user manual and all other documents provided with this appliance.

It is also possible to find the same information in EPREL using the link <https://eprel.ec.europa.eu> and the model name and product number that you find on the rating plate of the appliance.

INFORMATION FOR TEST INSTITUTES

Installation and preparation of the appliance for any EcoDesign verification shall be compliant with EN 62552. Please contact the manufacturer for any other further information, including loading plans.

PRIVACY

Worldwide Appliances respects your privacy and is committed to handling your personal information in accordance with the National Privacy Principles and the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth). A copy of the Worldwide Appliances Privacy Policy is available at www.artusi.com.au. Worldwide Appliances will not disclose any personal information set out in the Warranty Registration Card ("Personal Information") without your consent unless required by:

1. law;
2. any Worldwide Appliances related company;
3. any service provider which provide services to artusi or assist artusi in providing services (including repair and warranty services) to customers. Our purpose in collecting the Personal Information is to keep a record of the artusi product purchased by you, in order to provide a better warranty service to you in the unlikely event that there is a problem with your artusi product. Worldwide Appliances may contact you at any one or more of the address, email address or telephone numbers set out in the Warranty Registration Card. Please contact artusi on 1300 694 583 should you not wish to be contacted by Worldwide Appliances.

WARRANTY

1. Warranty

Worldwide Appliances warrants that each artusi product will remain, for a period of either 12 months or 24 months of warranty. All Warranties are valid from the original date of purchase, And warranty claims must be accompanied by the proof of purchase.

24 months warranty products:

All Built-in Appliances – Limited to Ovens, Gas, Induction and Electric Cooktops, and All Rangehoods. Freestanding Cookers - Gas and Electric Models (900mm Width).

Dishwashers - Freestanding, Fully Integrated, Semi Integrated and built-in. All Wine coolers. All Dryers. Freestanding Cookers - Gas and Electric Models in 50cm, 54cm and 60cm Widths
Portable Appliances* – Benchtop Models and Portable Gas Models

2. What is not Covered by the Warranty.

The Warranty does not apply if an artusi product is defective by a factor other than a defect arising in the manufacture of the artusi product, including but not limited to:

- (a) damage through misuse (including failure to maintain, service or use with proper care), neglect, accident or ordinary wear and tear (including deterioration of parts and accessories and glass breakage);
 - (b) use for purpose for which the artusi product was not sold or designed;
 - (c) use or installation which is not in accordance with any specified instructions for use or installation;
 - (d) use or operation after a defect has occurred or been discovered;
 - (e) damage through freight, transportation or handling in transit (other than when Worldwide Appliances is responsible);
 - (f) damage through exposure to chemicals, dusts, residues, excessive voltage, heat, atmospheric conditions or other forces or environmental factors outside the control of Worldwide Appliances;
 - (g) repair, modification or tampering by the purchaser or any person other than Worldwide Appliances, an employee of Worldwide Appliances or an authorised artusi service contractor*;
 - (h) use of parts, components or accessories which have not been supplied or specifically approved by artusi.
 - (i) damage to surface coatings caused by cleaning or maintenance using products not recommended in the artusi product handbook provided to the purchaser upon purchase of the artusi product;
 - (j) damage to the base of an electric oven due to items having been placed on the base of the oven cavity or covering the base, such as aluminium foil (this impedes the transfer of heat from the element to the oven cavity and can result in irreparable damage); or
 - (k) damages, dents or other cosmetic imperfections not affecting the performance of the artusi in respect of an artusi product purchased as a "factory second" or from display
- The Warranty does not extend to light globes used in artusi products.

3. Domestic Use

Each artusi product is made for domestic use. This Warranty may not extend to artusi products used for commercial purposes.

4. Time for Claim under the Warranty

You must make any claim under this Warranty within twenty eight (28) days after the occurrence of an event which gives rise to a claim pursuant to the Warranty, by booking a service call on the telephone number below.

5. Proof of Purchase

Customers must retain proof of purchase in order to be eligible to make a warranty claim in respect of an artusi product.

6. Claiming under the Warranty

Customers will bear the cost of claiming under this Warranty unless Worldwide Appliances determines the expenses are reasonable, in which case the customer must claim those expenses by providing written evidence of each expense to Worldwide Appliances at the address on the Warranty Registration Card.

7. Statutory Rights

(a) These terms and conditions do not affect your statutory rights.

(b) The limitations on the Warranty set out in this document do not exclude or limit the application of the consumer guarantees set out in the Act or any other equivalent or corresponding legislation in the relevant jurisdiction where to do so would:

(i) contravene the law of the relevant jurisdiction; or

(ii) cause any part of the Warranty to be void.
